

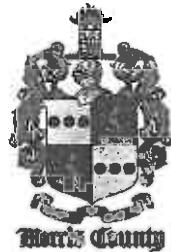

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Introduction

The New Jersey Solid Waste Management Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq.) established a comprehensive system for the management of solid waste in New Jersey. The Act designated all twenty-one (21) of the state's counties, and the Hackensack Meadowlands District, as Solid Waste Management Districts, and mandated the respective Boards of Chosen Freeholders and the Meadowlands Development Commission develop comprehensive plans for waste management in their respective districts. On January 29, 1981, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) approved, with modifications, the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP or Plan). The Act further requires that all new solid waste facilities be approved for Plan inclusion.

This document has been prepared to amend the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan to include the Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. class B concrete recycling operation in Jefferson Township, Morris County, New Jersey within the Plan.

Site Description

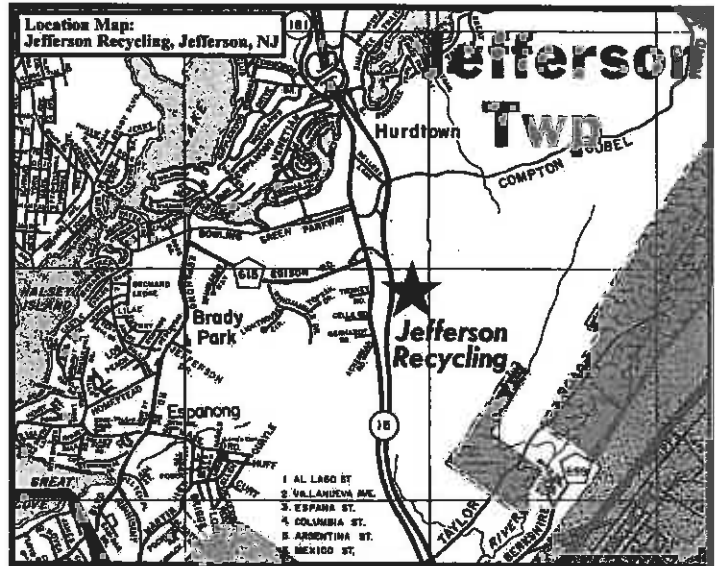


Figure 1: Location Map: Jefferson Recycling

Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. is located at 710 State Route 15 North, Jefferson Township, Morris County, New Jersey. It is situated on the northbound side of State Route 15 approximately 4 miles north of the intersection of I-80 and State Route 15 and just south of the Edison Road intersection with Route 15 (see Figure 1 for a location map). Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. is on block 272, lots 8 and 9 in Jefferson Township. The majority of the operation will occur on lot 8 which is 13.11 acres and a small portion of the site in the northwest corner is on lot 9 which is 0.82 acres. Both lots comprise the 13.93 acre site. It should be noted that there is a separate operation for the production of topsoil in the northwest corner of the property. This topsoil operation is not a regulated solid waste activity and is not the subject of this Plan amendment. The topsoil processing area occupies less than one acre (only about 6%) of the site. Other than sharing an access driveway to Route 15, there is no inter-relationship between the two operations.

Source Area

Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. intends to operate as a merchant facility open to the public. In addition to servicing residents and businesses of Morris County, this public facility is also expected to receive the permitted class B materials originating in Passaic, Essex, Hudson, Union and Bergen Counties. There are no restrictions placed on the source areas generating the material that can be accepted by Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C.

Type of Material

The only materials accepted at the facility will be class B recyclables limited to concrete, brick and block. These materials will be required to be source separated from garbage prior to delivery to the facility but may contain contaminants of asphalt, wood, and/or metal. The contamination should not represent more than approximately 1% of the incoming material by volume. Marketable residue such as metal or wood may be recycled while residue requiring disposal will be delivered to the Morris County transfer station in Mount Olive in accordance with the flow control requirements of the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan.

Facility Capacity

The daily capacity for the acceptance of the class B materials described above is 700 tons per day.

Materials Handling and Process Flow

Material Handling: The class B recycling operation will consist of accepting concrete, brick and block from customers of Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. The material will be dumped on site and pushed by bulldozer into the stockpile area for initial processing by an excavator equipped with a pulverizer to size reduce the material. The excavator will then load the material into a concrete crusher which will crush the material. An inclined stacking conveyer will deposit the finished material into two 35-foot stockpiles. Front-end loaders will then load the finished material into trucks for shipment to end markets. Under no circumstances will soil screened from the incoming loads of concrete be allowed to be mixed with the processed on-site topsoil operation which is not permitted as part of this class "B" operation. Additionally, the facility shall not accept concrete from sites undergoing remediation under the oversight of NJDEP's Site Remediation Program (SRP) or Licensed Site Remediation Program (LSRP).

Vehicle Flow: Access to the site is from the northbound lanes of Route 15 North heading into the existing driveway on the western boundary of the site. Traffic will be directed to the scalehouse at the center of the property whose scales will serve both inbound and outbound weighing responsibilities. From the scale inbound trucks will proceed to tip their materials in the raw concrete stockpile located just east of the concrete crusher. After tipping, the trucks will go back to the scalehouse to be weighed empty for billing and tracking purposes.

Traffic

It is estimated that approximately 30 trucks per day will deliver material to the site and approximately 30 trucks per day will take processed material from the site. Vehicles delivering material to the site are anticipated to be primarily 20 cubic yard dump trucks and/or roll-off containers. Dump trucks (20 cubic yards) are anticipated to be the type of vehicle that delivers material to market.

Hours of Operation

The facility will accept materials and operate in accordance with the following schedule:

- Monday – Friday – 7:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M

Access To The Facility

Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. shall grant access to designated representatives of the Morris County Solid Waste Advisory Council, Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority, Morris County Office of Health Management, Jefferson Township, Certified County Lead Agency from any county that waste is received from, Local Health Department, and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for the purpose of inspection of site operations and waste management records.

Municipal Input:

Appendix A includes a copy of a the Township of Jefferson Resolution No. 12-54 adopted on May 23, 2012 providing non-binding support for including the Jefferson Recycling Facility in the Plan.

Plan Amendment

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et. seq. Morris County proposes to include the class B processing operation owned and operated by operated by Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C., Township of Jefferson (block 272, lots 8 and 9), Morris County, New Jersey into the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan. A map illustrating the site location has been included in Figure 1.

This proposed plan amendment is in conformance with the approved SWMP by providing for the management of solid wastes generated in Morris County.

To insure the broadest possible participation by the general public in this plan amendment process, the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders will conduct a public hearing. All County residents, public officials or organizations interested in this action are encouraged to attend the public meeting and offer testimony.


WHEREAS, the Morris County Solid Waste Advisory Council has reviewed the application and deemed the application complete; and

- c) A record of the dates and results of all consultations with governmental agencies.

4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
