Administrative Action Request – Bednar Landscaping Services, Inc.

Plan Inclusion of Class C Compost Facility

Dear Guy:

In a letter and accompanying application dated May 2, 2012, Bednar Landscaping Services. Inc. ("Bednar"), located at the corner of Division and Wooton Streets, Boonton, NJ 07005 (Block 75.01; Lot 69), requested the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") be amended for the inclusion of Bednar's proposed facility. Bednar applied to be incorporated as a part of the Plan in accordance with the "Blanket Inclusion Policy – Vegetative Waste Compost and Recycling Centers."

In short, Bednar proposes to operate an exempt class C compost facility in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(a)13. The facility would accept less than 5,000 cubic yards annually of vegetative waste (leaves and grass) delivered exclusively from Bednar's own landscaping business for composting. For more details on the proposed facility, please see the included application provided by Bednar.

Item (g) of the Plan's blanket inclusion policy requires the adoption of a resolution by the Board of Chosen Freeholders once the blanket inclusion process has been completed. Bednar completed the requirements of the blanket inclusion application, including proper publications and notices, items (b) and (d) of the application, and no known objections and/or comments were raised regarding the proposed facility in accordance with item (e). As such, in a resolution dated July 11, 2012, the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders approved the inclusion of the Bednar facility. A copy of this resolution has been attached to this letter.

In summary, this letter is provided as an administrative action requesting that the Bednar facility, and operations of such, as per the attached May 2, 2012 letter and application be determined to be included in and consistent with the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan.

- 1. The aforementioned facility shall be deemed consistent with the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan.
- 2. The application for the blanket inclusion in the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan as a Class C Recycling Facility to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan submitted by Bednar Landscaping Services, Inc. (see attached Exhibit A) be and is hereby approved.
- 3. Pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 13:1E-24D, the modifications of the application be and are hereby deemed to be minor and do not require subsequent action by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Morris.



FACILITY DESCRIPTION NARRATIVE


Bednar Landscaping Services, Inc. ("Bednar") is a landscaping business with its sole and principal operating location at the corner of Division Street and Wooten Street/501 Division Street, Boonton, New Jersey (hereinafter the "Site"). Bednar has been in continuous operation at the Site for twelve years and currently employs 35 people. Bednar provides landscape services to commercial and residential customers and as a byproduct of that service it brings leaves and grass, to the Site for recycling and future use.

When leaves are delivered to the facility from a Bednar job, they are immediately placed in a windrow for composting. The placement of the single windrow is indicated on the Site Description Map (See Exhibit "B"). When grass is received at the Site, Bednar immediately incorporates the grass into the windrow and turns the grass into the windrow to prevent odors. The total volume of material in the windrow is less than or equal to 5,000 cubic yards of leaves and grass, with grass not to exceed 1 part per 5 parts of the volume of leaves. Bednar turns and reconfigures its windrow two times per month. When leaves and grass are delivered to the Site for recycling Bednar logs the volumes so that they can be reported to Boonton, the county and the DEP.

Bednar does not seek any expansion of its facility. Bednar will continue its operations as it has for many years and will not utilize its exemptions to accept materials from other landscapers or any other entities. Bednar only desires to continue its present business activity and to recycle byproducts from its own business activities for future use in compliance with DEP regulations in **Exhibit "D"**.







ADDRESSING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

- 1. ODORS: Odor is possible from the composting of leaves and grass in the windrow. A Bednar employee will walk the four corners of the Site once per day and create a log of his or her findings regarding any odor. If odor is detected, corrective action will be taken to turn and reconstruct the windrow. See also the Facility Narrative Description detailing that grass is immediately incorporated into the windrow and that the windrow is turned and reconfigured twice per month (this is the DEP mandated and best practice to eliminate odors).
- 2. <u>NOISE</u>: Noise is not anticipated from the turning and reconfiguring process in any significant degree as the process is done by a front end loader causing no more noise than a truck arriving or departing.
- 3. <u>DUST</u>: Significant dust is not anticipated from delivery of grass and leaves. Periodic watering of the windrow will be employed to minimize dust creation.
- 4. <u>VISUAL IMPACT</u>: Vegetative borders are in place around the recycling activity areas to minimize any visual impact.

Thank you for the information you sent me by email. I reviewed the regulations, N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(a)3, 13, 19 & 20. I decided that I do not need the leaf transfer exemption, #19, and attached is an updated Notification of exempt recycling activities form pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(b)5. I will also forward a copy of this form to the County of Morris. I am assuming you will need a receipt that I sent the updated form to the County also?

The Concrete Fact Sheet was especially helpful and I have decided to store the material in roll-off containers pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(a)7ii for continuous operation. I will update this information to the County and Department as well.

For exemption 13, I would like to apply for inclusion in the solid waste management plan under Morris County's blanket inclusion policy. The policy requires that I have an annual capacity of less than 5,000 cubic yards. My operations do not produce over 5,000 cubic yards a year but the exemption would be for up to 10,000 cubic yards. I will notify the County and Department that I will only have and will not go over 5,000 cubic yards and update my information on this issue as well. I realize that as we are still in the application process for the inclusion in the solid waste management plan, and we will have to pay an annual fee of \$1015 until we are approved. Would I send this check to your department in Trenton?

My attorney and I detailed and highlighted the regulations that pertain to us that we will follow, which is included in this fax. We will use this as a guideline to assure that we are in compliance with the County and the State of New Jersey regulations.

Please let me know if you need any other information from me or if I am missing anything.



Please see the attached notification of exempt recycling activities form along with the description of exempt activities that we are interested in conducting.

The two activities, #3 and #20, are the activities that we are able to comply to the DEP and Morris County regulations at this point in time.

We are also interested in recycling activity #13, however we realize we need to apply to be a part of the Morris County blanket solid waste management plan first.

We are in the process of applying for this status and will notify you and the DEP if and when we are accepted. We also will submit a new exempt recycling activities form for this statute once we get the go ahead.

We do not plan on processing more than 5,000 cubic yards of vegetative recycling material at our site, therefore believe we will be under the blanket policy.



Land use law amended

Effective Aug. 7, 1991, an amendment to the Municipal Land Use Law requires that notice of hearings on applications for approval of a major subdivision or a site plan, which require public notice, shall be given to all public utilities and cable television companies that own land or any facility or that possess a right-of-way or easement within 200 feet in all directions of the property which is the subject of such hearing. Engineers and others should obtain a copy of the amendment to insure compliance with the changes.
