#### **Poster Contest:**

- Each interested school will run the contest for students in grades 5 through 12.
- The school will display the posters for one week before submitting posters to MCMUA.
- **Two posters** chosen by the teacher or coordinator at the school will be submitted to the Morris County MUA for further judging (countywide) by July 1, 2023.
- The posters submitted will become the property of the Morris County MUA.
- The Morris County MUA plans to choose four (based on several entries) overall winners from grades 5 through 12 (contingent on significant participation, at the discretion of MCMUA). Two winners will be selected from grades 5-7, and two winners will be selected from grades 8-12. The artwork from the winning posters will be replicated on recycling containers donated to each school that submitted the winning posters. The delivery date of containers to schools is to be determined by MCMUA.
- Each winning artist (student) will receive a \$100.00 gift certificate for personal use.
- If students need help obtaining posterboard or markers, please call Cheryl at 973-285-8395. The MCMUA will provide the materials.

## **Posters MUST Include the following:**

(Please see the past winning poster below, which meets the criteria)

- The text, "Keep Morris County Litter Free!"
- Posters must be created on standard poster board, 22"x 28."
- Portrait Orientation ONLY
- Use bold colors and fill the posterboard (white spaces should be limited)
- Write the student's name, grade, & school on the back of the poster.
- Original artwork only, please. Computer-generated pieces are not accepted.
- Each poster is to be designed and created by **one student** only.

### Posters must include a theme from the list below.

- Litter abatement themes: keeping communities/public lands litter free.
- Changing the attitudes of those who litter, teaching others how to prevent litter.
- Protecting the environment, simple, thoughtful practices that make a difference.
- Reduce Waste: use a refillable water bottle to reduce single-use plastic bottles.
- The proper use of trash and recycling receptacles in public places: litter prevention!
