The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated October 2, 2017. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of Cip-Cycle Processing, LLC Class A Recycling Center to be located on Block 40, Lot 76.05 at 311 West Main Street in the Borough of Rockaway. The facility is proposed to be included in the County Plan for the acceptance and processing of up to 200 tons per day (tpd) of Class A recyclables (paper and cardboard) from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturday for acceptance and from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Saturday for processing.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)3, the inclusion of a new recycling facility for the acceptance and processing Class A recyclables can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of Cip-Cycle Processing, LLC Class A Recycling Center to be located in the Borough of Rockaway for the acceptance and processing of up to 200 tpd of Class A recyclable materials is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
