The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 8, 2016. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of additional Class B materials, specifically source-separated trees, tree parts, tree stumps, brush and leaves at the Jefferson Recycling, LLC Class B recycling center located at 710 State Route 15 North, Block 272; Lots 8 & 9 in the Township of Jefferson. The acceptance of these additional Class B materials would be included in the facility's currently approved 700 tons per day capacity.


Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, a modification of an existing recycling center, including the acceptance of additional materials, constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this administrative action is hereby approved pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a Class B Recycling Center General Approval Modification to Jefferson Recycling, LLC for the above noted operational change.

**RE: Administrative Action Request: Plan Inclusion Modification
Jefferson Recycling, Class B Recycling Facility**

Dear Mr. Brubaker:

In a letter dated January 14, 2016, Jefferson Recycling, L.L.C. ("Jefferson Recycling"), currently operating at a permitted class B recycling facility at 710 State Route 15 North (Block 272; Lots 8 & 9 in the Township of Jefferson), requested the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") be modified and updated with respect to the Plan's current inclusion of the Jefferson Recycling class B recycling facility. This recycling facility was originally and formally included in the Plan by means of a June 2012 Plan amendment as certified by NJDEP on December 10, 2012. After receiving an NJDEP class B permit in 2013, in accordance with this June 2012 Plan amendment, Jefferson Recycling has been operating ever since.


In its January 14, 2016 letter, which has been attached, Jefferson Recycling requested to expand the class B materials it is permitted to accept and process at its facility. Jefferson Recycling's original Plan inclusion allowed for the acceptance of up to 700 tons per day of only concrete, brick and block. The request for administrative action seeks to modify the Plan inclusion for this facility to now also include the receipt and processing of additional class B materials, specifically "source separated whole trees, tree trunks, tree parts, tree stumps, brush and leaves, provided they are not composted," as defined in N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.3. The acceptance of these additional class B materials would be included within the facility's current 700 ton per day capacity and as such, there is no request to increase the approved capacity of the facility from the currently approved 700 tons per day.

State regulations, specifically N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11 (b)-5, allow for modifications to be made to the Plan with respect to the acceptance of additional materials as well as proposing modifications to on-site operation of existing facilities through an administrative action procedure. This administrative action procedure permits the county's designated implementing agency, which is the MCMUA, to submit a letter to the NJDEP describing and requesting the changes to the Plan in lieu of going through the more formal and time-consuming Plan amendment process. The MCMUA formally requests the Plan be modified as described above in accordance with this administrative action process.

Although not specifically required by N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11 (b)-5, the MCMUA requested the host municipality of Jefferson Township to forward its opinion on this change prior to the MCMUA requesting this administrative action. In a resolution adopted by its Council on March 2, 2016, Jefferson Township authorized, consented and endorsed the proposed modifications to the Plan as described above. Copies of correspondence related to this host municipal opinion have been attached for your information.

Dear Mr. Gindoff:

As you are aware, Cascino Engineering represents Jefferson Recycling, LLC, (hereinafter Jefferson) operators of the DEP approved Class B Recycling Center referenced above for concrete type materials located at 710 State Route 15 North, Block 272, Lots 8 & 9, in Jefferson Township, N.J. After receiving approval from Morris County for inclusion within their Solid Waste Management Plan in 2012, Jefferson received their necessary permits from the NJDEP on 1/9/13, with approved modifications through 10/27/14.

As you are also aware, the Class B Recycling Center is permitted to accept up to 700 tpd of concrete, brick and block, one of the permitted Class B Recyclable materials as defined at NJAC 7:26A-1.3. During their course of operations over the last few years, Jefferson has determined a need to receive and process an additional type Class B material as defined at NJAC 7:26A-1.3 specifically, "Source separated whole trees, tree trunks, tree parts, tree stumps, brush and leaves, provided they are not composted."

Therefore, Jefferson has authorized me to submit on their behalf an application to modify their existing inclusion permit within the Morris County Solid Waste Management Plan to also include the processing of this additional type of Class B recyclable, **without exceeding their present capacity of 700 tpd**. Jefferson believes they can accommodate this additional processing within the previous areas approved for processing with a minor change which adds an area for tree, etc., processing just east of and contiguous to, their concrete processing operation. This additional processing area is depicted on the revised Site Plan enclosed. Jefferson is not requesting any other changes to their existing permit other than permission to accept and process this type of Class B material under all other conditions of their present permit.

RECYCLING LICENSE TO PERMIT RECYCLING OF TREES,
TREE TRUNKS, TREE PARTS, STUMPS, BRUSH AND LEAVES**

WHEREAS, Jefferson Recycling presently exists as a recycling center with the Township of Jefferson at 710 Route 15 North (Block 272, Lots 8 and 9, as shown on the Township Tax Map); and

WHEREAS, said recycling facility presently has approval as a Class B recycling center to recycle concrete, brick and block; and

WHEREAS, the recycling center has petitioned the Morris County Utilities Authority and the NJDEP to expand its Class B license to permit recycling of source separated whole trees, tree trunks, tree parts, tree stumps, brush and leaves; and

WHEREAS, the MUA has asked for the endorsement of the Township for said plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has reviewed the application and supports the expansion of the Class B recycling license as aforementioned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Township Council supports the inclusion of the Jefferson Recycling facility, located at 710 Route 15 North, in the Township of Jefferson, to have its Class B recycling license expanded to include source separated whole trees, tree trunks, tree parts, tree stumps, brush and leaves, provided that the capacity of the facility, which is a maximum of 700 tons per day, is not exceeded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Morris County Solid Waste Advisory Council (SWAC) and the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority.
