**Notice to Bidders for Sealed Bids for the
Purchase of One or more Stationary Compactor System**

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (MCMUA) seeks to purchase one or more stationary compactor system, including receiver box, to be used for single-stream recyclables. The work under this Bid shall include the furnishing, delivery and installation of the compactor(s) as more particularly described in the Bid Documents.

Sealed Bids will be received on **Friday, May 5, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.** at the offices of the MCMUA, located on the campus of the County College of Morris at 214 A Center Grove Road in Randolph Township and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Bids shall be in accordance with the Bid Documents on file with the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority.

No Bids will be received unless made in writing on forms furnished.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31, et seq. (N.J.A.C. 17:27-1, et seq.) (Equal Employment Opportunity), 42 U.S.C. § 12101, et seq. (Americans with Disabilities Act), N.J.S.A. 52:32.-44 et. seq. (Business Registration), and N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 (Corporation and/or Partnership Owner Information), all as same may be amended, amongst other requirements.

Bid Documents may be obtained on or after April 19, 2017 at the offices of the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority, during regular business hours between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or by submission to the MCMUA of a written request for email, postal or overnight delivery to Bidder. Any overnight delivery charges shall be paid by Bidder.
