DUE TO CHANGING RECYCLING MARKETS, SHREDDED PAPER IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED IN MOST RECYCLING PROGRAMS.

DID YOU KNOW...





Although paper is recyclable, it presents a unique challenge at recycling sorting facilities when it is shredded.

The shreds are too tiny to be captured by the sorting process. Instead, they create an unintended issue by contaminating other recyclables at the facility.

WHAT CAN BE DONE INSTEAD OF SHREDDING...

- Only shred documents that contain sensitive information.
- Keep shredding to a minimum.
- Cross out sensitive information with a black magic marker or identity protection roller.


