
The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated December 14, 2010. The December 14, 2010 request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of five modifications of the FCR Morris Class A Recycling Center located at 103 – 105 Iron Mountain Road in the Township of Mine Hill. Specifically, the December 14, 2010 request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of:

- 1) A change in the name of the owner of the subject facility from FCR Morris, Inc. to FCR Morris, LLC;
- 2) Block 201, Lot 29.01 to the site footprint of the subject facility, which was previously limited to Block 201, Lots 32 and 31.01;
- 3) An increase in the subject facility's capacity from 100 tons per day (tpd) of Class A recyclables to 550 tpd of same;
- 4) Acceptance at the subject facility of commingled or non-commingled newspaper, corrugated cardboard, magazines, newspaper inserts, paperboard boxes, junk mail, office paper, paperback books, cardboard food and beverage containers, mixed rigid plastics, plastic #4, #5, and #7 beverage containers, non-bottle and beverage containers made of plastics #1 and #2, aluminum foil, aluminum trays, and aseptic cartons; and
- 5) A change in operating hours for the subject facility from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday to 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, Monday through Saturday.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the inclusion of modifications of an existing recycling center constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, the December 14, 2010 request for administrative action to the County Plan is hereby approved pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
