The Compost

The Municipal Utilities Authority of Morris County, New Jersey operates a large compost facility in Budd Lake, which is permitted by the NJ DEP. This site processes local materials like leaves, grass and brush, utilizing a windrow process and turning equipment, as well as checking times and temperatures, in order to manufacture a consistent high-quality finished product. This compost is being tested on a regular basis at the Rutgers University Soil Testing Laboratory. Lab analysis is available for project submittal with support from Naturcycle staff. Commercial sales of this compost are sold under the brand name Naturcycle Compost "MT."
