Poster Contest:

- Each interested school will run the contest for students in grades 5 through 12.
- The school will complete the enclosed form and this agreement/signature page and return it by mail, (or scanned copy by email) by, 5/1/21 to confirm participation.
- **Posters must be created on a <u>standard poster board, 22" X 28.</u>" Portrait style (not landscape).**
- Each poster is to be designed and created by <u>one student</u> only (this is not a group project).
- Original artwork only, please. Computer-generated pieces will not be accepted.
- The school will display the posters for one week before submitting posters to MCMUA.
- **Two posters** chosen by the teacher or coordinator at the school will be submitted to the Morris County MUA for further judging (countywide) by July 1, 2022.
- The posters submitted will become the property of the Morris County MUA.
- The Morris County MUA plans to choose four (based on the number of entries), overall winners, from grades 5 through 12 (contingent on significant participation, at the discretion of MCMUA). The artwork from the winning posters will be replicated on recycling containers that will be donated to each of the schools that submitted the winning posters. The delivery date of containers to schools is to be determined by MCMUA.
- Each winning artist (student) will receive a \$200.00 gift certificate for their personal use.

The poster's content <u>must include</u>: a theme from the list below Posters <u>must include the following text:</u> "Keep Morris County Litter Free!"

List of Poster Content Themes:

- Litter abatement themes: keeping our communities/public lands litter-free.
- Changing the attitudes of those who litter teaching others how to prevent litter!
- Protecting the environment, simple thoughtful practices that make a difference!
- Reduce Waste: use refillable water bottles to reduce single-use plastic bottles!
- The proper use of trash and recycling receptacles in public places; litter prevention!
- Put disposable PPE: masks, gloves, wipes, into proper trash containers, do not litter!
