NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority, Rebid for the Mount Olive Tipping Floor Restoration, Contract No. 2021-1, and will be opened and read in public at the Authority Office, 214A Center Grove Road, Randolph, New Jersey 07869 on **Friday, April 29, 2022 at 10:00 A.M.**, prevailing time.

Due to the Covid19 State of Emergency, the bid opening at the MCMUA will be conducted using remote meeting software which will be made available to the public with both video and audio capability as the MCMUA offices will be closed during the bid opening. Members of the public are invited to participate in the bid opening using the provided video and audio-conferencing services. One half hour prior to the bid opening, using both a telephone number with conference call access number to join the bid opening as well as a web link to join the live bid opening will be posted on the MCMUA's website at <http://mcmua.com>.

All bids will be scanned and available for viewing within 24 hours of the bid opening on the MCMUA website; www.MCMUA.com

All bids must be submitted on the bid proposal forms provided in the bid documents in order to be considered.

The work includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in these Specifications and shown on the Plans to construct floor topping at the Mount Olive Transfer Station. The Transfer Station Building is located on the South Side of Gold Mine Road. The work will include the following: shotblasting existing concrete slab and driveway apron; placement of approximately 16,000 SF of concrete floor topping; installation of new trench drain; extension of observation deck slab; replacement of pipe bollards; and steel railing.

Plans, Specifications and forms of bid for the proposed work prepared by the Alaimo Group, Authority Engineer, have been filed in the office of said ENGINEER, at 2 Market Street, Paterson, New Jersey 07501, and may be inspected by prospective bidders during the regular business hours. Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Specifications, Plans and Proposal by the ENGINEER at the cost of preparation thereof, \$45.00, nonrefundable; plus \$10.00 postage and handling if mailed. Checks shall be made payable to the ALAIMO GROUP.

Bidders who have previously submitted bids for this project will be furnished a new set of Plans and Specifications at no charge.

Bids must be made on the standard Proposal form in the manner designated therein and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside, addressed to the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority, and must

be accompanied by Certified Check, Bid Bond or Cashier's Check drawn to the order of the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority for ten percent (10%) of the total amount bid, provided said security need not be more than \$20,000.00. All bid guarantees shall be accompanied by an executed consent from an approved surety company, licensed to conduct business in the State of New Jersey, agreeing to furnish the required Performance and Maintenance Bond upon the award of contract.

- If bidders feel it is necessary to hand deliver the bid submission, they are to follow the instructions posted on the door of the MCMUA Office Building located at: 214A Center Grove Road, Randolph, NJ 07869 during current business hours of 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Any bidder choosing to enter the building to secure delivery of the bid must wear gloves and face mask as proper PPE.

The signed Proposal forms and bid security must be delivered to the place and on or before the hour named above. The accepted bidder must sign the contract within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award or forfeit his bid security. Bid securities will be returned to all but the three apparent lowest responsible bidders. All other bid securities will be returned within three days after awarding and signing of the contract and approval of the Contractor's Performance Bond, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays excepted.

This contract is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.

Prospective Bidders are cautioned not to rely solely on this Notice to Bidders in preparing their Bids, but to read the Bid Documents in their entirety and comply with all bidding requirements set forth therein. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 (Affirmative Action Law); P.L. 2004, c.57 (Business Registration Act); and P.L. 2003, c.91 (Public Works Contractor Registration Act).

Sealed bids for this project are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

The right is reserved to reject any or all Proposals, in whole or in part, or to make awards to such bidder or bidders who, in the judgment of the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority is the lowest responsible bidder and to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.
