Scope of Engagement

Nisivoccia will conduct an Annual audit of the financial statements of the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025 in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America and prescribed by the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey, as required by N.J.S. 40:14A-7.1, et seq.

Our audit will include tests of your accounting records and other procedures we consider necessary to enable us to express an unmodified opinion that your financial statements are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. If our opinion were other than unmodified, we would fully discuss the reasons with you in advance.

Our audit is not specifically designed and cannot be relied upon to disclose deficiencies in internal controls. However, during the audit, if we become aware of such deficiencies or ways that we believe management practices can improve, we will communicate them to you in a separate letter to those charged with governance. We encourage and are available for routine consultation throughout the year to continually evaluate the operating effectiveness of the deficiency and the solutions. We believe strongly that timely communication of any deficiencies identified by management is essential to serving you promptly, effectively and efficiently.

In addition to the compliance phase of governmental auditing, our approach, which is consistent with the present state of the art, places great emphasis on looking beyond the accounting entries to the underlying operations and day-to-day business situations which give rise to the entries. We believe that it is important for us to gain an insight into various conditions which affect our clients' financial position and operations.

This approach is commonly referred to as the "business approach" to auditing. In accomplishing this, we obtain an understanding of the organization and the systems and procedures which comprise the entity's system of internal accounting controls.
