In response to the RFP issued on March 18, 2025 for municipal solid waste transportation and disposal services for the County's municipal solid waste received at Mount Olive Township and Parsippany-Troy Hills Township transfer stations, Casella Waste Systems, Inc. ("Casella") respectfully declines to submit pricing for service at this time.

While we do not foresee Casella's current infrastructure to be an immediate, competitive solution for the County at the time, we are willing and able to offer the County redundant, back-up disposal capacity within our network of disposal facilities, should the County need it.

We would be happy to meet with the County to explore how our infrastructure could provide optionality or redundancy in the near or long term.
