	Revise the recycling ordinance and submit a copy to the MCMUA – Section 9.2.(b) Submit to the MCMUA a copy of the ordinance on recycling in multifamily housing according to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.13a – Section 9.2.(b) Designate a municipal recycling enforcement coordinator – Section 8.6. Submit a copy of the section of the municipal master plan pertaining to certain development proposals as specified in Section 9.2.(c), along with a copy of the process used by the appropriate municipal department to determine that the development proposals have met the municipality's requirements – Section 9.2.(b)
	Complete and submit recycling tonnage report to DEP – Section 9.2.(e)  Every 6 months, create and send notice to generators (residents (both single and multifamily homes), businesses, and institutions) of recycling opportunities and requirements.
