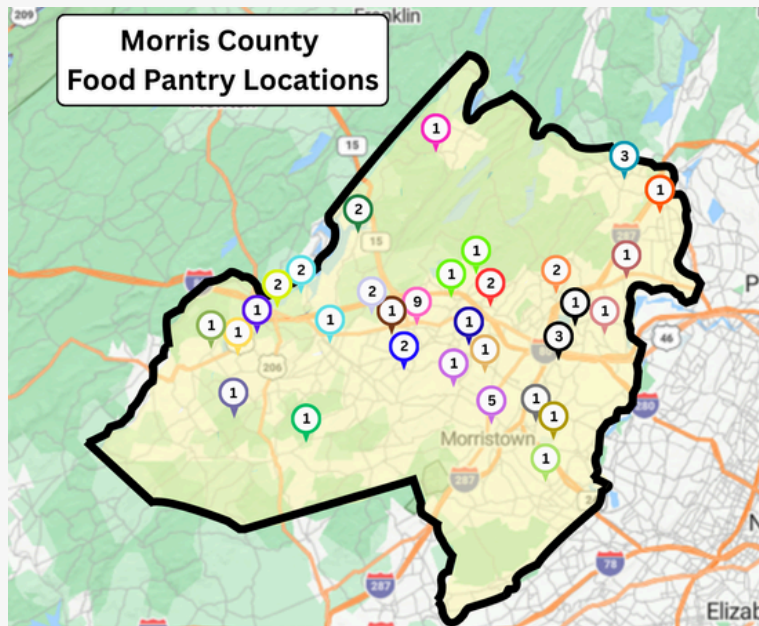

Why Should My Business Reduce My Food Waste?

Tax Deductions

Depending on the type of corporation your business is, you may **deduct donated food inventory up to 15% of taxable income** (IRC §170(e)(3)).

NJDEP Regulations

About **12.5% of US households** suffer from food insecurity (EPA).

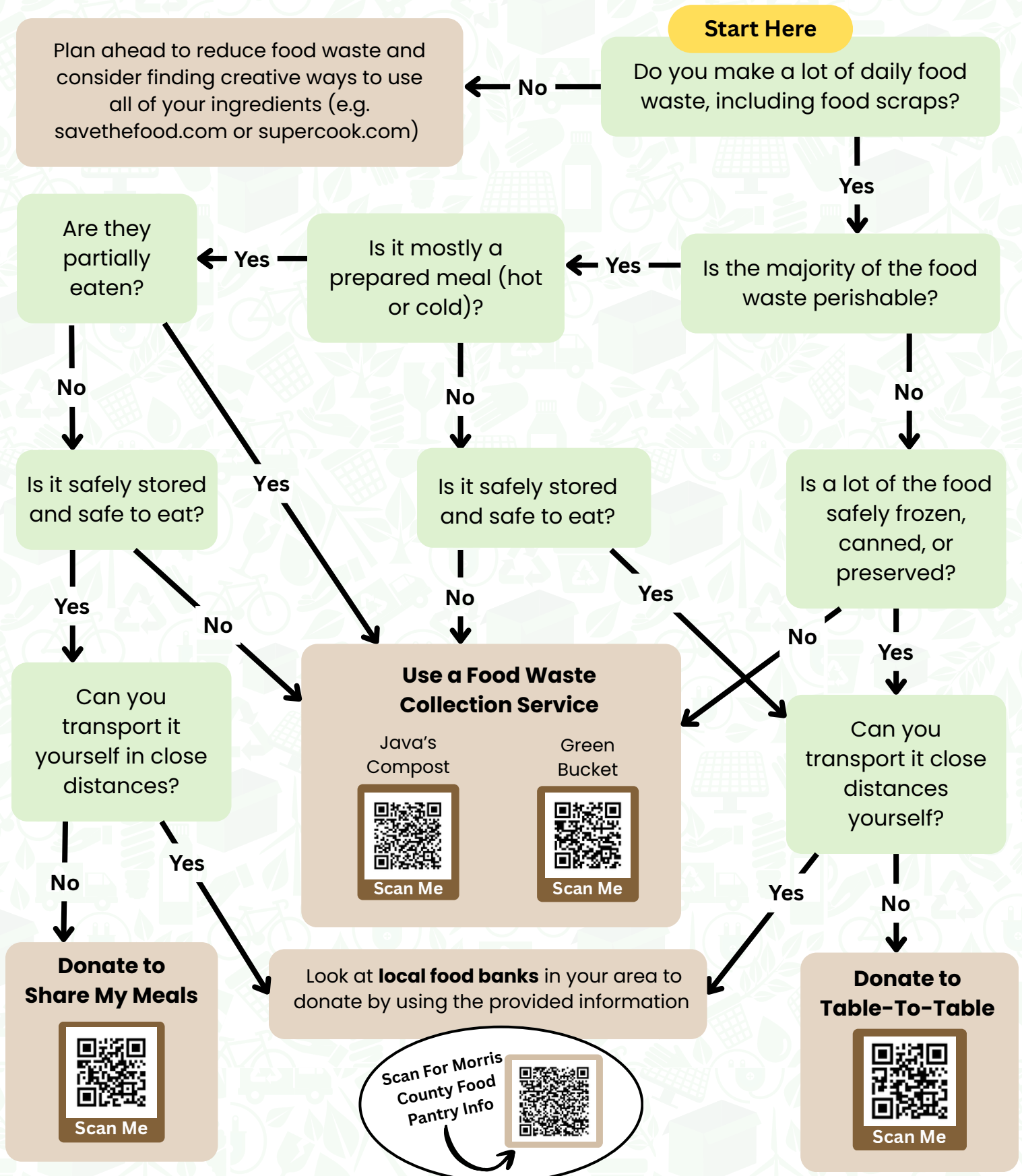
Reduce Food Waste
