The Compost

The Municipal Utilities Authority of Morris County, New Jersey operates a large compost facility in Parsippany, which is permitted by the NJ DEP. This site processes local materials like leaves, grass, and brush, utilizing a windrow process and turning equipment, manufacturing a consistent high-quality finished product. The resulting compost is enrolled in the United States Compost Council’s Seal of Testing Assurance certification program. This program is a series of standards and regular independent testing for agronomic factors and plant viability, as well as health and safety. Lab analysis is available for project submittal with support from Naturcycle staff. Commercial sales of this compost are sold under the brand name Naturcycle Compost “PT.”
