Paper

Cardboard, office paper, junk mail, envelopes, shredded paper, flyers, file folders, newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs, paperbacks and phone books, paper bags, tissue boxes, paper towel cores, toilet tissue rolls, frozen food boxes, cartons and boxes used for milk, juice, soup, broth, etc., clean pizza boxes, 6-pack and 12-pack cartons from soda and beer.



The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority is now offering single-stream recycling services to businesses and institutions.

Plastic

Plastic bottles and small rigid plastic non-bottles coded:



The "all-in-one," single-stream recycling collection program allows cans, bottles, cardboard and all other paper to be mixed together in the same container.

Metal

Aluminum and steel (tin) cans, loose metal jar lids, steel bottle caps, clean aluminum foil, pie plates and trays.



Glass

Glass bottles and jars.



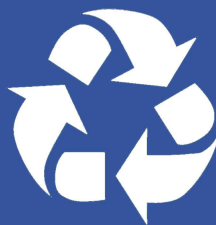
