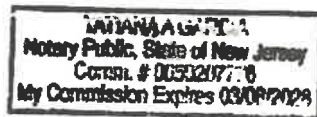

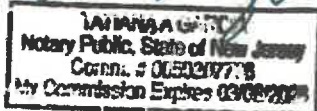

The applicant has submitted a copy of its notice of approval dated June 15, 1995, after meeting the requirements of N.J.S.A. 13:1E-126 et seq. (A-901). It has also submitted tariff sheets that set forth in the uniform tariff format the rates to be charged for these services.

After review of the application as filed, the Department FINDS that the Applicant has met the necessary requirements as to financial responsibility, A-901 approval, experience and training to be granted a Certificate. Therefore, the Department HEREBY AUTHORIZES the issuance of a Certificate identified as SW No. 1989, to engage in the solid waste business in New Jersey as specified herein above. Operations authorized herein are subject to the

rights and duties of public utilities as set forth in Title 48, New Jersey Statutes Annotated and Title 7, New Jersey Administrative Code.

This Order shall not limit, prevent, or in any manner affect the authority of the Department or State to institute any proceeding, civil, criminal, regulatory, or administrative, in any federal or state court or agency with respect to anti-trust, monopoly, or restraint of trade issues, "fitness to serve", the existence of effective competition or other activities of the parties to this proceeding. Nor shall this Order limit, prevent, or in any manner affect the authority of the Department, or any federal or state court or agency.

Should the fitness to serve of Allstate Power Vac, Inc. be successfully challenged in any legal and/or administrative proceeding, or should Allstate Power Vac, Inc. or its owners, officers or employees be found to have violated any statutory or regulatory provision, the Department hereby reserves its right to amend, change, and/or rescind such provisions of this Order, as in its judgment the public good may demand.

Further, this Order grants approval to operate only to the extent consistent with the application and supporting documents incorporated and requested herein by reference. Should Allstate Power Vac, Inc. expand the scope of its solid waste operations without providing the Department with the appropriate notice, the Applicant shall be subject to penalties and fines pursuant to applicable law.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:49-4.1, a business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required, or that provides false business registration information, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000, for each proof of business registration not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency.

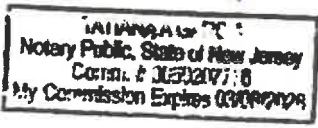



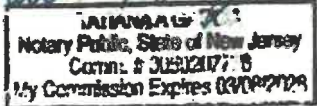
